Setup

Brian Sommerville and /or Neil Massingham are the Mini-roo coordinators, please see them in the control room when you arrive for instructions. Committee members will also be at the ground if you have any questions.

- Arrive at field 7:45am
- Mark fields if required
- Setup mini fields with goals, corner flags, field # flags and control ropes
- Setup back field with goals, corner flags and control ropes
- Put the half field goals out behind the Mini-roo fields ready for changeover
- Put out rubbish bins
- Put out witches hats to indicate Ambulance gates

Changeover

While only 2 teams are assigned setup duty it would be appreciated if all Mini-roo teams playing on the day would help out with changeover by bringing in flags and/or goals, as directed by the MiniRoo Coordinator or Committee Member. On most occasions there is only 5 minutes to do the changeover and everyone helping will make it a much quicker task.

- Remove Mini-roo goals
- Remove Mini-roo corner flags, leave half field corner flags
- Remove internal ropes, leaving the ropes at the front and back of half fields

Ground Control

If you are wearing the Ground Control (Orange) vest then you must not leave the grounds until you have a replacement from the next team to takeover.

- All teams must have a manager wearing the yellow managers vest at every game
- Each team on setup must supply 1 Ground Control person wear the orange vest
- Assist with the positioning and pegging down of the across field goals and the tasks as described under Changeover
- Each U8 – U11 team playing at Billa Road must supply 1 Ground Control person to wear an orange vest
- Ground Control orange vests can be found in the control room
- Please return the vests if you are the last team playing



Pack-Up

- All goals, ropes, flags & bins must be packed away after all games.
- Each team playing the last game will be on pack-up duty
- Move all equipment to the container ready to be packed away, large goals can be slotted together and the back field goals will fit inside them
- Rubbish bins have to go into the bin cage ready to be put out on Monday night
